Growing Together supports Community Projects that:

- are run by organisations with a significant track record of delivery in the field concerned
- benefit people living in Blackthorn/Cherry Lodge, Goldings/Overstone Lodge, Lings or Lumbertubs estates
- involve the community in delivering the project
- address at least one of our programme priorities. These are tackling crime and the fear of crime, investing in young people, improving the local environment, supporting the independence of older or disabled people, bringing together our diverse and changing community especially by promoting the inclusion of new communities and marginalised people N.B. that with effect from April 2016 the Partnership has decided to give priority to projects other than those benefitting children and young people, due to the high amount of expenditure on such projects to date. Applications from projects that will benefit this age group are still welcome.
- advance Growing Together's overall goal of encouraging and enabling residents to look after each other and their environment
- work to be as accessible as possible to all appropriate sections of the community, including those with the most limited financial means
- provide good value for money
- offer something to the community that would not otherwise be provided
- will continue to deliver benefits after the grant runs out

Grants cannot be made to individuals, for-profit organisations or to projects that are principally designed to promote a religious or political viewpoint.

There are no deadlines and no upper or lower limits. All applications will be considered at the next available meeting of our Community Partnership Board, which meets monthly except August and December. You *may* be asked to attend the meeting to discuss your application. Our Programme Co-ordinator will give you any help you require in completing your application and may suggest changes to help give your application the best possible chance of success.
